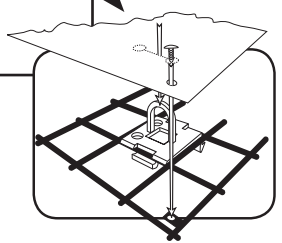
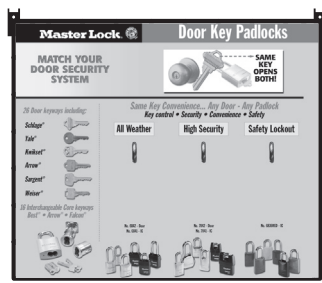
1 Hasp Installation

- Repeat for each hasp.



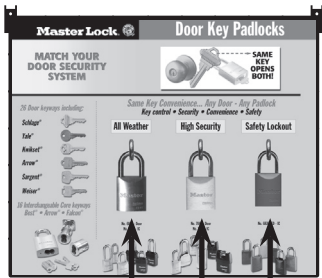
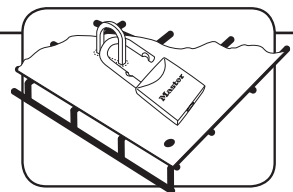
2 Display Panel Assembly

- After inserting hasp plate and attaching the display panel, screw in nuts on U-bolt as far as possible.
- Place washers on U-bolt before inserting U-bolt through display panel and hasp plate.
- Tighten using Lock Nuts.
